

HEALTH & SAFETY NOTICE

Every reasonable and practical care will be taken to safeguard those who use these premises in good faith and in accordance with the Law.

Under the Health & Safety Act a regular Risk Assessment is made, and within those parameters the following should be noted:

- Unauthorised entry up the Bell Tower is not permitted.**
- Unauthorised use of the Carillon is not permitted.**
- Irregular and uneven surfaces provide part of the unique character of the premises and its surrounding grounds, thereto users are advised to exercise due care and caution at all times inside and outside, and in particular in adverse or wet weather.**
- Whilst every care is taken to maintain the fabric and masonry, visitors' attentions are drawn to the age of the property and its natural regression and maturity.**
- Running is not permitted on any of the premises.**
- No person shall interfere with, or handle, or climb on, tombstones, their surrounds or graves, without the express permission of the Parochial Church Council in writing.**

The Parochial Church Council exercises a Duty of Care and hold a Public Liability Insurance; they will make every effort to minimise hazards and advise the public of their obligation to abide by the restrictions and directions published for their welfare.

Where Contractors are employed they shall provide their own liability insurance.
